

**2011 Orange County Fair Speedway & Orange County Fair  
DEMOLITION DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS  
6 - 8 CYLINDER CLASS  
Orange County Fair - Sunday, July 17th & July 31st  
OCFS Eve of Destruction - Saturday, September 17th**

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**DRIVER ENTRY RULES:**

1. **DRIVER MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. NO EXCEPTIONS**
2. Driver must supply his/her own car.
3. **Car numbers will be assigned at the time of registration. Front doors must be painted white on BOTH sides of the car and the number painted or affixed in large DARK colors. Additionally, number must be painted or affixed to ROOF of car.**
4. Driver must show picture I.D. drivers license at payoff.

**GENERAL RULES:**

1. **ONLY DRIVERS, OWNERS OR MECHANICS will be permitted in the pit area.**
  2. Upon entering the Demo Derby, drivers and crewmembers must adhere to proper and sportsmanlike conduct. **Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification with no refunds.**
  3. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA. DRIVERS AND CREW MEMBERS FOUND WITH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED WITH NO REFUNDS.**
  4. **NO OBSCENE GRAFFITI** will be allowed on cars. If violated, cars will be disqualified and not allowed on the track with no refunds.
  - 5 Drivers must make contact with another car every 60 seconds or they will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the starter/officials. If a driver does not hit a LIVE car within the limit, this will lead to disqualification.
- Do Not Play Possum.**
- 6.No head-on collisions.
  - 7 No hitting in the drivers door. You will be disqualified immediately.
  - 8 The winner will be the last car to make a hit and be able to move away.
  9. The winner may be re-inspected before being declared the winner.
  10. **Decision of the official is final.**
  11. A protest may be lodged. The cost will be \$200. \$50 will be paid to the inspector. \$150 will be paid to either the protestor or the protested depending upon inspectors decision. This must be paid in cash before feature.
  12. **The management reserves the right to change any rule or rules if they feel it is necessary and refuse any entry at their discretion. The interpretation of the rules shall be determined by the Orange County Fair and Speedway officials. Their decision is final. There are no appeals.**

**CAR SET-UP & INSPECTION RULES:**

1. Drivers **must** wear a regulation helmet (**Snell 95 or better**) and an approved seatbelt in working order.
2. **No convertibles, trucks, or Chrysler Imperials!** Any make of automobile allowed.
3. Car must be completely gutted with the exception of the front seat.
4. **ALL GLASS MUST BE REMOVED** (not broken in doors or tailgates). Windshield is optional. If removed, screen (strong wire or mesh) must be used with a strong chain, wire or strap in the middle in place of windshield to prevent hood from coming into the driver compartment.
5. Absolutely NO stripping of vehicles in speedway area.
6. Cars with fiberglass panels,these panels must be removed.
7. One battery may remain under the hood or may be to the front area of the car **but must be covered and fastened securely.** If battery remains under hood, there must be a hole in the hood over battery.
8. A 12+hole must be cut over the carburetor in case of fire.
9. Doors must be chained or welded shut. Two (2) welds on each door will be permitted, not to exceed 3+each in length Hoods and trunks must be chained with 6 (six) chains, NO BOLTS. Tailgates may be chained or welded with the same specs for welding as the doors. Welding to be on the skin only - no interior welds. A 3+post/bar may be placed 1 ft. (12 inches) below and behind the seat from driver to passenger side. **BLACK PIPE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.**
10. Bumpers and body must remain stock. **No reinforcements of any kind.** No trailer hitches. Bumper height max is 24+(inches) to the top of the bumper. NO chains from bumper front or rear to hood. Bumpers may be chained to the frame. **All shocks must be moveable. Bumper can be welded to frame.**
11. Stock gas tanks **must** be removed. Gas tank may be relocated to above the rear end in the trunk or in the back seat of the car. Gas tanks **must** be securely fastened down with chain. Gas tank **must** be metal outboard motor type with **no more than 3 (three) gallons of gasoline.** Gas tank **must** have a metal firewall covering it and securely fastened.

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12. Tires must be a stock 14+- 16+car tire. No more than 6 ply. **Street legal only.** No truck tires, no snow tires on drive wheels of the car (if front wheel drive, then none on front. If rear wheel drive, then none on rear).
13. All vehicles with electric fuel pumps in tank must have a shut-off valve on dash within driver's reach.
14. **RADIATORS MUST BE DRAINED OF ALL ANTI-FREEZE! NO FREON! USE WATER ONLY!**
15. Trunk must be totally empty. It is no longer permitted to mash down the rear section of any vehicle.
16. **IF IT IS NOT IN THE RULES ...IT IS NOT LEGAL!!!!**

**INSPECTION TIMES FOR JULY 17<sup>TH</sup> & JULY 31<sup>ST</sup> AND SEPTEMBER 17<sup>TH</sup>:**  
**OFFICIALS WILL INSPECT CARS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 1:00PM- 4:00PM. ANY CARS SHOWING UP LATER THAN THIS TIME CANNOT BE GUARANTEED THAT THEY CAN RUN THE DERBY.**

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION for the O.C. FAIR and EVE OF DESTRUCTION DEMOLITION DERBY'S:**

These events will be composed of individual heats and feature with cash prize going to each heat winner and grand prize to the feature winner. Feature will be comprised of winners and runner-ups of each heat when the show is a single derby event or the feature will be comprised of winners of each heat from each show when there are two (2) or more derby events.
