

2010 Demolition Derby Rules & Regulations
MINIVAN CLASS
For Sunday, May 2nd, Orange County Fair & Eve of Destruction

DRIVER ENTRY RULES:

1. **DRIVER MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Driver must supply his/her own van.
4. **Van Numbers will be assigned at the time of registration. Front doors must be painted white on both sides of the van and the number painted or affixed in large bright colors.**
5. Driver must show picture I.D. drivers license at payoff.

GENERAL RULES:

1. **ONLY DRIVERS, OWNERS OR MECHANICS will be permitted in the pit area.**
2. Upon entering the Demo Derby, drivers and crewmembers must adhere to proper and sportsmanlike conduct. **Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification with no refunds.**
3. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA. DRIVERS AND CREW MEMEBERS FOUND WITH ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED WITH NO REFUNDS.**
4. **NO OBSCENE GRAFFITI** will be allowed on vans. If violated, vans will be disqualified and not allowed on the track with no refunds.
5. Drivers must make contact with another van every 60 seconds or they will be subjected to disqualification at the discretion of the starter. If a driver does not hit a live van within the limit, this will lead to disqualification. **Do Not Play Possum.**
6. No head-on collisions.
7. No hitting in the drivers door. You will be disqualified immediately.
8. The winner may be re-inspected before being declared the winner.
9. **Decision of official is final.**
10. **The Management reserves the right to change any rule or rules if they feel it is necessary and to refuse any entry at their discretion. The interpretation of the rules shall be determined by the Orange County Fair officials. Their decision is final. There are no appeals.**

VAN SET-UP & INSPECTION RULES:

1. Driver **must** wear regulation helmet (**Snell 95 or better**) and approved seat belt in working order.
2. NO full size vans or conversion vans ALLOWED.
3. Seats may be removed. Driver's seat must be securely mounted. Van must have seatbelts chained and bolted to the frame.
4. **ALL GLASS MUST BE REMOVED** (headlights, taillights, windshield, rear window and side windows). Vans with sunroofs must remove the glass and weld or bolt sheet metal to the roof.
5. Absolutely NO stripping of vehicles in speedway area.
6. Battery may be moved to any position under the hood of the van – Not inside the van
7. Doors must be securely fastened shut (chained, bolted or welded).
9. Bumpers may not be removed. **No reinforcing of any kind.** No bumper hitches allowed. Bumper height max is 24" (inches). No more than two (2) bolts holding trunk and hood. NO chains from bumper front or rear to hood. Bumpers may be chained to the frame.
10. Gas tank may **NOT** be relocated and **must** be securely fastened down. Gas tank **must** be metal outboard motor type with **no more than three (3) gallons of gasoline.** Gas tank **must** have a metal firewall covering it and securely fastened. **No** auxiliary gas tank.
11. No truck tires or snow tires on drive wheels of the car (if front wheel drive car than none on front; If rear wheel drive, then none on the rear). No ballast or tires inside the van.
12. All vehicles with electric fuel pumps in tank must have shut-off valve switch on dash within driver's reach.
13. **RADIATORS MUST BE DRAINED OF ALL ANTI-FREEZE! NO FREON! USE WATER ONLY!**
14. Chassis may not be reinforced. Front and rear sheet metal may not be reinforced.

INSPECTION TIMES FOR MAY 2ND: OFFICIALS WILL INSPECT CARS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:00 (NOON) – 2:00PM. ANY CARS SHOWING UP LATER THAN THIS TIME CANNOT BE GUARANTEED THAT THEY CAN RUN THE DERBY.

INSPECTION TIMES FOR JULY 25TH, AUGUST 1ST AND SEPTEMBER 18TH: OFFICIALS WILL INSPECT CARS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 1:00PM–4:00PM. ANY CARS SHOWING UP LATER THAN THIS TIME CANNOT BE GUARANTEED THAT THEY CAN RUN THE DERBY.
